ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY INTERIM RELIEF

Alberta Jackson, of 1106 W. 42nd Street, Los Angeles 37, California, having filed a verified complaint alleging in substance that complainant has had telephone service under this name furnished by defendant from 1945 until October 1961; that a friend of complainant's daughter, one Frances (unknown), while complainant was not at home, asked to use complainant's telephone allegedly to arrange for her children to be taken to a doctor; that said Frances was later taken into custody and complainant's telephone removed from the wall by police officers; that complainant is informed and believes that the matter was dismissed as to said Frances; that complainant had no knowledge that the phone had been used by Frances, and that if the telephone was used for an illegal purpose it was done without the knowledge and consent of the complainant; that complainant's daughter and two grandchildren reside with her, and because of the children and her employment, it is vitally necessary that she have use of a telephone; and complainant having requested an order directing defendant to

restore telephone service; and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Pacific Telephone Company is hereby directed to reconnect and restore telephone service to complainant and to maintain such service pending further Commission order herein, said service to be furnished pursuant to defendant's filed tariff rates and rules applicable thereto. The complaint will be set for hearing before such Commissioner or Examiner, and at such time and place, as may hereafter be designated.

The Secretary is directed as follows:

1. To cause a certified copy of this order, together with a copy of the complaint herein, to be served upon the Pacific Telephone Company, and said defendant is directed to serve and file its reply within ten (10) days after said service.
2. To cause a copy of this order to be mailed to complainant.
3. To cause appropriate notice of hearing to be mailed to the parties at least ten (10) days prior to the hereing herein.
