ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 61412, Mueller Truck Co. was authorized to operate as a public utility warehouse in National City, California. It is alleged that applicant has concluded financial arrangements for new warehouse facilities and that construction will commence in the very near future. It is requested that the time within which to establish service be extended to December 31, 1962.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph 3(b) of Decision No. 61412 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"On or before December 31, 1962, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the Public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective tariffs satisfactory to the Commission."

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
