 tracks of the Southern Pacific Company,)
 in Tulare County, referred to as "Avenue)
 328 Overcrossing."

O R D E R

State of California, Department of Public Works, is here-
 by authorized to construct County Avenue 328 at separated grades
 over the track of Southern Pacific Company, near Goshen Junction,
 Tulare County, at the location and substantially as shown in the
 application as amended to be identified as Crossing No. B-236.5-A.
 Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance
 with an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto,
 and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing
 approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the
 Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties
 fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construc-
 tion and maintenance by further order.

Upon completion of Crossing No. B-236.5-A, the existing
 public grade crossing at Crossing No. B-237.6 (County Avenue 320),
 located about 1.1 miles easterly, shall be abolished by physical
 closing by Southern Pacific Company.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this
 order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This
 authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless

time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
