In the Matter of the Application of Pacific Electric Railway Company for authority to construct, operate and maintain a drill track across Baldwin Park Boulevard in the City of Industry, County of Los Angeles.

ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company is hereby authorized to construct a drill track at grade across Baldwin Park Boulevard, in the City of Industry, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6T-20.96-C.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 3 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

Applicant declares that the industry to be served will require rail service in the near future and requests waiver of the twenty-day waiting period.

The effective date of this order shall therefore be the date hereof.
