SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 62515, dated September 5, 1961, granted a water service certificate to applicant. This grant was made conditional upon applicant's installing satisfactory defluoridation equipment. Applicant reported by letter dated May 16, 1962 to the State Department of Public Health that such equipment had been installed. It enclosed a report from a consulting engineer upon its operations. Copies of both letter and report have been filed with the Commission. It appears that the condition of the certificate grant has been met. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to applicant by ordering paragraph 1.a. of Decision No. 62515 shall become effective on the effective date of this order.
