SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

It appearing that the Commission in ordering paragraph 1
 of Decision No. 62184, provided:

"1. The certificate granted in the foregoing paragraph of
 this order shall not become effective until applicant shall
 have provided for the continuation of a reasonably adequate
 supply of water, in case of failure of applicant's single
 existing well and its related pumping unit, by installing and
 placing in operation at the site of said well a storage tank
 of 33,000 gallons capacity, or larger, and a booster pump or
 pumps capable of delivering at least 300 gallons per minute
 from said tank into the distribution system, all in a
 manner acceptable to the Commission, and shall have so
 notified the Commission in writing after the effective date
 of this order.", and

It appearing that Vista Water Co., Inc., has complied
 with the requirements set forth in said ordering paragraph,

Now Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 62184 is effective on the date hereof.

2. In all other respects Decision No. 62184 is in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
