OPINION AND ORDER

This is an application by the County of Santa Clara which seeks authority to install flashing light signals at the crossing of Buena Vista Avenue and the railroad tracks of the Southern Pacific Company and to physically close the crossing of Denio Avenue and the Southern Pacific railroad tracks.

The Commission directed that an Examiner's Proposed Report be filed in the matter. The Proposed Report of Examiner Donald B. Jarvis was filed on June 14, 1962. The time in which to file exceptions to the Proposed Report expired on July 5, 1962. No exceptions were filed. The Commission has reviewed
