## OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant holds radial highway common carrier, highway contract carrier and city carrier permits and a certificate to operate as a highway common carrier. By Decision No. 62166, dated June 20, 1961, in Application No. 43423, it was authorized to assess rates less than the applicable minimum rates for shipments of frozen pies, cakes, cookie rolls and dough for the Carnation Company from the Los Angeles Territory to San Francisco Territory, Fresno, Sacramento, Chico and certain intermediate points, and fresh frozen fruits and berries from certain of the aforenamed places and Watsonville to the Los Angeles Territory. This authority is scheduled to expire July 30, 1962. By this application, authority is sought to continue to charge less than the minimum rates otherwise applicable for a further one-year period.

Applicant states that there has continued to be a substantial movement of the traffic embraced herein and that the shipper has informed applicant that it will continue to use the service offered by applicant in substantially the same manner and extent as it has in the past. Attached to the application is a profit and loss statement for the year 1961 which indicates that the operations involved herein have been conducted at a profit. Applicant asserts that it has experienced certain increased costs but it believes it can continue to operate profitably at the same rates.

Applicant's highway common carrier certificate does not apply to the transportation of the commodities involved herein.

The verified application shows that a copy thereof was served upon the shipper and the California Trucking Associations, Inc., on or about May 29, 1962. No objection to its being granted has been received.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the proposed rates and surcharge as more specifically set forth in Appendix A hereof are reasonable. A public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

Good cause appearing.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Gould Transportation Co., Inc., operating as a highway permit carrier, is hereby authorized to transport frozen cakes, frozen pies, frozen cookie rolls, and frozen dough, in straight or mixed shipments, and fresh frozen fruits and fresh frozen berries for the Carnation Company at less than established minimum rates, but not less than those set forth in and subject to the provisions shown in Appendix A attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 2. The authority granted herein shall, on and after July 30, 1962, supersede the authority granted by Decision No. 62166 and shall expire with July 30, 1963.

The effective date of this order shall be July 30, 1962. Dated at San Francisco, California, this 17th day of July, 1962.
