OPINION AND ORDER

The Greyhound Corporation requests authority to reroute seven of its urban routes within the City of San Diego.

It is alleged that for the past several years the City of San Diego has been in the process of establishing a one-way street pattern in the downtown area; that in furtherance of this program, effective June 7, 1962, First Avenue will be restricted to northbound traffic and Front Street will be restricted to southbound traffic; that to conform to the traffic pattern it will be necessary to redescribe Urban Routes Nos. UR-12.03, UR-12.05, UR-12.06, UR-12.07, UR-12.08, UR-12.12 and UR-12.13.

After consideration the Commission finds and concludes that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing is not necessary.

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to The Greyhound Corporation, authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as that term is defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express between the points and over the routes set forth in Second Revised Page 79 and Third Revised Page 80 attached hereto, as an extension

and enlargement of, consolidation with and subject to all the limitations and restrictions set forth in the certificate granted by Decision No. 55893 and particularly to the provisions set forth in Section 3 of Appendix A thereof.

2. Appendix A of Decision No. 55893 is hereby amended by incorporating Second Revised Page 79 and Third Revised Page 80.

3. In providing service pursuant to the certificate granted in Ordering Paragraph 1 hereof, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
- (b) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in the Commission's office in triplicate tariffs and timetables satisfactory to the Commission.
- (c) The tariff and timetable filings shall be made effective not earlier than five days after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff and timetable filings shall be concurrent with the establishment of the service herein authorized.
- (d) The tariff and timetable filings made pursuant to this order shall comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs and timetables set forth in the Commission's General Orders Nos. 79 and 98.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.

- *UR-12.03 - From junction Kettner Boulevard and Beech Street, over Beech Street to India Street to Ash Street to First Avenue to B Street to Front Street.
- UR-12.04 - From junction Pacific Highway and Ash Street, over Ash Street to India Street.

- UR-12.09 - From junction Pacific Highway and Broadway, over Pacific Highway to Harbor Drive to the City Limits of San Diego, en route to San Ysidro.

- UR-12.14 - From junction Main Street and Twenty-Eighth Street, over Twenty-Eighth Street to junction Harbor Drive.
- *UR-12.15 - From junction Market Street and First Avenue, over First Avenue to B Street.
