## ORDER

State of California, Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to construct State Route 3 (U.S. 99) at separated grades over the track of Southern Pacific Company, at Cottonwood, Shasta County. at the location as shown by map (Exhibit B) attached to the application. and substantially as set forth in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. C-240.0-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement now being negotiated between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of G.O. 26-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be
