ORDER DENYING REHEARING
AND MODIFYING DECISION

Bill Taylor, doing business as Bill Taylor Trucking, having petitioned for a rehearing of Decision No. 63229, the Commission having considered said petition and being of the opinion that no good cause for rehearing has been shown,

IT IS ORDERED that rehearing of Decision No. 63229 is hereby denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said decision is modified by deleting the second sentence in ordering paragraph No. 1 and by substituting therefor the following:

"Respondent shall not, by leasing the equipment or other facilities used in operations under these permits for the period of suspension, or by any other device, directly or indirectly allow such equipment or facilities to be used to circumvent the suspension."

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
