OPINION AND ORDER

William W. Lynch and Albert W. Gatov each requests a license to operate as a motor transportation broker. However, each was granted a license on January 26, 1962. Applicant Lynch was granted his license by Decision No. 63185 in Application No. 44083, and applicant Gatov was granted his license by Decision No. 63186 in Application No. 44084.

The purpose of the present filings is apparently to comply with Section 4833 of the Public Utilities Code which reads as follows:

"The commission shall not issue a motor transportation broker license to any copartnership or corporation, it being the intent of this chapter to require each person acting as a motor transportation broker to be individually licensed. If an applicant is an officer or commission agent or employee of a corporation, or a member of any copartnership, or a commission agent or employee of any person or copartnership, he shall so state in his application. The corporation, copartnership, or person of which the applicant is an officer, member, or employee, as the case may be, shall join in the applicant's application and shall set forth therein the relationship between the applicant and the person, copartnership, or corporation so joining."

In their original applications applicants indicated that they were officers of Westwarehouses, Inc., a Nevada corporation, and said corporation complied with Section 4833 by joining in the applications. The instant applications indicate that applicants are also officers of Trans-Oceanic Agencies, a Nevada corporation, and that said corporation along with Westwarehouses, Inc., has joined in the new applications. Each applicant has increased the surety bond on file with the Commission from \$1,000 to \$2,000.

In view of the fact that applicants are presently licensed as motor transportation brokers and the instant applications were filed so as to comply with Section 4833 of the Public Utilities Code,

IT IS ORDERED that the filings in Applications Nos. 44482 and 44483 shall be considered as amendments to Applications Nos. 44083 and 44084 and the motor transportation broker licenses heretofore issued to William W. Lynch and Albert W. Gatov by Decisions Nos. 63185 and 63186 shall remain in effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
