## ORDER

City of Sacramento 1s hereby authorized to construct Florin Road at grade across the relocated track of Southern Pacific Company in the City of Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application, as amended, to be identified as Crossing No. AU-95.4. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than eighty-nine feet and grades of approach not greater than one percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by four Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order No.75-B) equipped with reflectorized "STOP ON RED SIGNAL" signs.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.
