OPINICN

San Diego Transit System seeks authority to discontinue operation of its Route "J" - Ocean Beach-Convair Astronautics line. Route "J" service is operated on a special shift-hour basis for employees of the Convair Astronautics Plant.

Service was established in March, 1958, beginning with two round trips per day leaving Ocean Beach at 6:05 a.m. and 7:10 a.m., and leaving the plant at 4 p.m. and 5:10 p.m. In April, 1961, the latter round trip was discontinued due to lack of patronage. Patronage on the remaining round trip has steadily declined to the point where only an average of approximately ten passengers per day in each direction utilize the service. The trend of employment at the plant has been declining for some time indicating a further decrease in patronage. Applicant alleges that the service is being operated at a weekly loss of approximately \$84, or an annual loss of approximately. \$4,380. Present patrons will not be entirely without public transportation since they will have available regular Route "O" service from Ocean Beach to downtown San Diego from which point applicant operates its Route "G" service directly to the Astronautics Plant.

A copy of the application has been served on Mr. J. R. Mitchell, Chief of Employees Services of the Convair Astronautics Plant, and on the City of San Diego. The application is not opposed.

The Commission finds that public convenience and necessity no longer require the operation of said Route "J". The application will be granted. A public hearing is not required.

ORDER

Application having been made, the Commission being fully advised in the premises and having found that public convenience and necessity no longer require the operation of Route "J", and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. San Diego Transit System, a corporation, may discontinue its Route "J" Ocean Beach-Convair Astronautics line effective concurrently with the effective date of tariff filings required by paragraph 2 hereof.
- 2. Applicant shall, within sixty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, amend its tariff and time schedules to reflect the authority herein granted.
- 3. Appendix A of Decision No. 55090 is hereby further amended by cancelling First Revised Page 12A, and by incorporating in said Appendix Eighth Revised Page 2 and Fourth Revised Page 5 in revision of Seventh Revised Page 2 and Third Revised Page 5, respectively, as attached hereto and made a part hereof.

4. Applicant shall post a clearly legible notice of discontinuance of service in its Route "J" bus for at least one week prior to discontinuance.

The effective date of this order shall be ten days after the date hereof.
