ORDER

Oceanside Harbor District is hereby authorized to construct a pedestrian crossing at separated grades under The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's Main Line in the City of Oceanside, San Diego County, at the location described and substantially in the manner as shown in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 2-225.3-BD.

Construction and maintenance expenses shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between applicant and The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company and a copy of said executed agreement together with plans of the pedestrian undercrossing, approved by the railway, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencement of construction.

Within thirty days after completion of the undercrossing, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not

complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
