## OPINION

A member of the Commission's staff having determined, after examination and appraisal as provided by Section 5135 of the Public Utilities Code, that applicant was not qualified, the matter was set for hearing.

A public hearing was held in the above-entitled matter at San Francisco on July 19, 1962, before Examiner John Power.

Applicant appeared at the Commission's office on July 17, 1962 for a second examination. He decided, however, not to take it. Neither did he appear at the hearing, although a Commission employee reminded him of the hearing on July 17.

A Commission staff member testified that applicant is not qualified to operate the proposed household goods service.

Upon consideration of the application and examination, and the evidence of qualification presented at the hearing, the Commission finds that applicant does not possess sufficient knowledge to perform the services of a Household Goods Carrier.
