OPINION

A member of the Commission staff having determined, after examination and appraisal as provided by Section 5135 of the Public Utilities Code, that applicant was not qualified, the matter was set for hearing.

A public hearing was held in the above-entitled matter at San Francisco on July 19, 1962, before Examiner John Power. There were no protests to the application.

Applicant now has no permits. Until November 1961, he had a household goods carrier permit and conducted operations pursuant thereto at San Francisco under four business names.

It appeared at the hearing that, at the time of the examination, applicant was deficient in his understanding of the distance rates in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-A and of Distance Table No. 4.

A Commission staff member testified that applicant is now qualified to operate the proposed household goods service on a limited basis.

Upon consideration of the application and examination, and the evidence of qualification presented at the hearing, the Commission finds that applicant possesses sufficient knowledge, ability, integrity, financial resources and responsibility to perform the services of a Household Goods Carrier as set forth in the following order.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that, on the effective date of this decision the Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause Household Goods Carrier Permit No. 33-7805-EG to be issued to Allen J. Mossmayer, inserting therein conditions and restrictions limiting applicant's operation to points within thirty constructive miles of San Francisco or within the Metropolitan San Francisco - Oakland Area, as described in Item No. 347-A Series of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-A or both.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
