ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct a side track at grade across Arena Way near Livingston, Merced County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. B-139.0. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with level grades of approach. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (G.O. No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic gate arms. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant desires to begin construction as soon as possible and has requested immediate authorization. Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
