ORDER AMENDING DECISION
AND DENYING REHEARING

California Interstate Telephone Company and Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, having each filed petitions for rehearing or modification of Decision No. 63885, and the Commission having considered said petitions and each and every allegation therein, and it appearing from the record that it was the intent of California Interstate Telephone Company in its proposals to achieve rate concurrence with Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company as to intrastate private line rates, and that such result is just and reasonable, an amendment and modification of the decision to affirm that fact and clarify the decision and order ^{being} appropriate;

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 63885 is hereby amended by modifying the sentence appearing in Appendix A, page 9 of 9 under private line services, to read as follows:

The installation charges and monthly rates shown under the columns headed "Proposed" in Exhibit 16, or such installation charges and monthly rates for intrastate private line service as may be in effect for Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company on the effective date of this order, are prescribed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, good cause for rehearing herein not having been made to appear, in all other respects Decision No. 63885, as above amended, is affirmed and the petitions for rehearing denied.
