## ORDER AMENDING DECISION NO. 62997 AND VACATING ORDER GRANTING REHEARING

A petition has been filed seeking clarification of the Commission's order granting rehearing herein. Said order limited the scope of rehearing to the question "whether public convenience and necessity require the applicant's service in the San Diego Territory as defined in Decision No. 62997." Petitioners seek clarification of the words "in the San Diego Territory." "In the San Diego Territory" is synonomous with "within the San Diego Territory" and does not include traffic between points one of which is outside of said territory and one of which is inside of said territory.

It appearing that by letter of June 16, 1962, hereby made part of the record herein, applicant advised the Commission that it did not protest the Commission's denying of operating authority "in the San Diego Territory as defined in Decision No. 62997" and did not intend to be present at the scheduled rehearing of said application.

By reason of the foregoing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Appendix "A" of Decision No. 62997 is hereby amended by incorporating therein First Revised Page 1 attached hereto in revision of Original Page 1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that since the order granting partial rehearing herein appears to be moot, it is hereby vacated and set aside, and rehearing of Decision No. 62997 is hereby denied.

Appendix A

## Mainline Transportation System (a corporation)

First Revised Page 1 Cancels Original Page 1

Mainline Transportation System, a corporation, is authorized to transport general commodities between all points in the Los Angeles Basin Region as defined in Appendix B attached hereto, on the one hand, and all points in the San Diego Territory as defined in Appendix B attached hereto, on the other hand.

Mainline Transportation System shall render no service locally between (a) points within the Los Angeles Basin Region or (b) points within the San Diego Territory. The operating authority hereinabove set forth does not include the right to render service to, from or between points intermediate between the Los Angeles Basin Region and the San Diego Territory.

Mainline Transportation System shall not transport shipments of:

- 1. Used household goods and personal effects not packed in accordance with the crated property requirements set forth in paragraph (d) of Item No. 10-C of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-A.
- Automobiles, trucks and buses; viz., new and used, finished or unfinished passenger automobiles (including jeeps), ambulances, hearses and taxis; freight automobiles, automobile chassis, trucks, truck chassis, truck trailers, trucks and trailers combined, buses and bus chassis.
