O P I N I O N

A member of the Commission staff having determined, after examination and appraisal as provided by Section 5135 of the Public Utilities Code, that applicants were not qualified, the matter was set for hearing.

A public hearing was held in the above-entitled matter at San Francisco, on July 20, 1962, before Examiner John Power.

Applicants also have applied for Radial Highway Common Carrier Permit No. 38-7476 and City Carrier Permit No. 38-7433 and will operate pursuant thereto at 251 Capp Street, San Francisco, under the fictitious firm name and style of Romano's Moving & Transfer.

An employee of this firm took examinations on April 11, 1962 and July 18, 1962.

It appears that this employee's difficulty was with the rates between northern and southern California. The staff stipulated that the employee was qualified for points within 75 miles of San Francisco.

A Commission staff member testified that applicants are now qualified to operate the proposed household goods service on a limited basis.

Upon consideration of the application and examination, and the evidence of qualification presented at the hearing, the Commission finds that applicants possess sufficient knowledge, ability, integrity, financial resources and responsibility to perform the services of a Household Goods Carrier as set forth in the following order.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that, on the effective date of this decision, the Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause Radial Highway Common Carrier Permit No. 38-7476; City Carrier Permit No. 38-7433; and Household Goods Carrier Permit No. 38-7533 to be issued to Eugene Romano and Harold Banks, inserting in said Household Goods Carrier permit conditions and restrictions limiting applicants' operation so that they may operate between points both of which are within 75 constructive miles of San Francisco.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
