A member of the Commission's staff having determined, after examination and appraisal as provided by Section 5135 of the Public Utilities Code, that applicants were not qualified, the matter was set for hearing.

A public hearing was held at San Francisco on July 19, 1962 before Examiner John Power.

Applicants possess Radial Highway Common Carrier Permit No. 38-7782 and City Carrier Permit No. 38-7783 and are operating pursuant thereto at 147 Webster Street, San Francisco under the fictitious firm name and style of Bar Bell Transfer Co.

A staff witness testified that Mr. Donald L. Martin (the examinee) appeared to be ill on May 8, 1962, at his first examination.

A Commission staff member testified that upon re-examination applicant Martin appeared qualified to operate the proposed household goods service, limited to the San Francisco-Oakland Area and within 30 constructive miles of San Francisco.

Upon consideration of the application and examination and the evidence of qualification presented at the hearing, the Commission finds that applicant Martin possesses sufficient knowledge, ability, integrity, financial resources and responsibility to perform the services of a Household Goods Carrier as set forth in the following order.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that, on the effective date of this decision, the Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause Household Goods Carrier Permit No. 38-7796 to be issued to Donald L. Martin, Elmer L. Jacobs and Dean Freeman, inserting therein conditions and restrictions limiting applicants' operation to points within 30 constructive miles of San Francisco or within the Metropolitan San Francisco - Oakland Area as defined in Item No. 347-A Series of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-A.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
