ORDER VACATING ORDER OF  
SUSPENSION OF OPERATIVE RIGHTS

Decision No. 63807 dated June 12, 1962, in these proceedings, provided for the suspension of the certificate of public convenience and necessity of Frank L. Nolan and Mary F. Bartholomew, copartners, doing business as Frank Nolan Drayage Co., unless they shall have filed with this Commission prior to the effective date of that decision the proper and lawful freight tariffs as required by Sections 486 and 493 of the Public Utilities Code in which event the effective date of that order would be stayed.

On June 26, 1962, C. R. Nickerson, Agent, filed tariff revisions reinstating Frank L. Nolan and Mary F. Bartholomew, doing business as Frank Nolan Drayage Co., as participants in Pacific Coast Tariff Bureau Exception Sheet No. 1, Cal.P.U.C. No. 4, and San Francisco-East Bay Cartage Zone Local Freight Tariff No. 15, Cal.P.U.C. No. 18, effective July 30, 1962, thereby staying the Commission's order. Inasmuch as the required tariffs are now on file, Decision No. 63807, supra, will be vacated and set aside.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 63807 dated June 12, 1962, in Applications Nos. 35417 and 36818, is hereby vacated and set aside.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
