OPINION AND ORDER

The Commission staff having determined, after examination and appraisal as provided in Section 5135 of the Public Utilities Code, that the proposed transferee was not qualified for a permit as a Household Goods Carrier, the matter was set for hearing.

A public hearing was held in the above-entitled matter at Los Angeles, on August 1, 1962, before Examiner Mark V. Chiesa.

The evidence shows, and we find, that the responsible managing employee designated by The Bellmasi Corporation to take the examination in accordance with the provisions of Section 5135 of the Public Utilities Code, has failed the written examination, and that said corporation is not qualified for a Household Goods Carrier permit.

Although applicants were duly served with copies of the notice of hearing, no one appeared in their behalf.

The Commission having found that The Bellmasi Corporation does not possess the qualifications for a Household Goods Carrier permit,

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 43931 is denied.
