This is an application to transfer a household goods carrier permit. A member of the Commission's staff having determined, after examination and appraisal as provided by Section 5135 of the Public Utilities Code, that the proposed transferee was not $\frac{1}{}$ qualified, the matter was set for hearing. A public hearing was held at San Francisco on July 20, 1962 before Examiner John Power.

Applicant, Clyde E. Reynolds, now has Radial Highway Common Carrier Permit No. 41-580 and City Carrier Permit No. 41-1312 and is operating pursuant thereto at 1315 Hancock Street, Redwood City, California, under the firm name of Reynolds Bros. Transfer & Storage.

It appeared at the hearing that on February 13, 1962 Mr. Reynolds passed a second examination. A Commission staff member testified that applicant is now qualified to operate the proposed household goods service.

Upon consideration of the application and examination, and the evidence of qualification presented at the hearing, the Commission finds that applicant possesses sufficient knowledge, ability, integrity, financial resources and responsibility to perform the services of a Household Goods Carrier as set forth in the following order.

<u>ORDER</u>

IT IS ORDERED that, on the effective date of this decision, the Secretary of the Commission shall cause Household Goods Carrier Permit No. 41-1581 to be issued to Reynolds Bros. Transfer & Storage, Inc., inserting therein conditions and restrictions limiting applicant's operation to the period of time during which (1) Clyde E. Reynolds remains as an officer or employee of Reynolds Bros. Transfer & Storage, Inc., or (2) some other officer or employee qualifies and is approved by Commission order.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
