O R D E R

The City of Los Angeles is hereby authorized to construct Denker Avenue at grade across the track of the Pacific Electric Railway Company's Torrance Line at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6RCA-16.71, and to improve and widen the existing crossing of 208th Street (Crossing No. 6RCA-16.70), in the City of Los Angeles, Los Angeles County. Width of crossings shall be in accordance with plan attached to the application, and grades of approach not greater than one percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by four Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B), two for each crossing.

Clearance with respect to traffic islands shall be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Construction and maintenance costs shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties and a copy of said executed agreement, together with plans approved by the railway, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencement of construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the

Commission will apportion the costs of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
