## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 64002 dated July 24, 1962, in this proceeding, Minimum Rate Tariff No. 8 was amended to provide that the minimum rates named therein for the transportation of fresh fruits and vegetables would also apply to the transportation of nuts, in the shell or field shelled.

It has come to the Commission's attention that the amended tariff rate items may not indicate clearly the application of the rates to the commodity in question. The tariff will be clarified.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 8 (Appendix "C" to Decision No. 33977, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective October 27, 1962, Twelfth Revised Page 29, Eleventh Revised Page 30, Twelfth Revised Page 33, Fifth Revised Page 38 and Sixth Revised Page 41, which revised pages are attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

In all other respects said Decision No. 33977, as amended, and Decision No. 64002 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
