O P I N I O N

A Commission staff member having determined, after exam-
 ination as provided in Section 5135 of the Public Utilities Code,
 that applicant had not qualified for household goods carrier permit,
 the matter was set for hearing at Los Angeles on August 1, 1962,
 before Examiner Chiesa.

At the hearing a Commission witness testified that appli-
 cant had been reexamined and had made a passing grade and was now
 qualified for a permit. Applicant's testimony also shows that he
 possesses the knowledge and ability to perform the services as a
 household goods carrier. His financial condition, as shown on the
 application, shows Total Assets of \$41,450 and Total Liabilities of
 \$1,043.93 as of February 15, 1962.

Protestant did not present evidence but assisted in the
 development of the record.

The Commission having considered the matter, finds that applicant possesses the requisite qualifications and financial resources and responsibility to perform the services of a household goods carrier as set forth in the following order.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that on the effective date of this decision the Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause Household Goods Carrier Permit No. 19-55126 to be issued to Robert W. Finney, inserting therein conditions and restrictions limiting applicant's operation to an area within a radius of 50 miles of the post office in the community of Wilmington, situated in the County of Los Angeles.

The effective date of this order is twenty days after the date hereof.
