OPINION AND ORDER

A Commission staff member having determined, after exam-
ination and appraisal as provided in Section 5135 of the Public
Utilities Code, that applicant is not qualified for a household
goods carrier permit, the matter was set for hearing at Los Angeles
on August 2, 1962, before Examiner Mark V. Chiesa.

The evidence shows that applicant failed his first exam-
ination. He was accorded two opportunities to take a second
examination, one on July 27, 1962, at which time he made
no appearance, and another on July 31, 1962, which he declined.

Said staff member testified that applicant had failed to
qualify.

Applicant presented no evidence of his qualifications and
his testimony indicated that he has been operating without the
necessary authority.

The Commission, having considered the matter, finds that applicant does not possess the requisite qualifications for a household goods carrier permit.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 44553, of Elmer E. Gunning, be and it hereby is denied.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
