## OPINION AND ORDER

A. Comolssion staff member having determined, after examination and appraisal as provided in Section 5135 of the Public UEilities Code, that applicant is not qualified for a bousebold goois emnier permit, the matter was set for hearing at Los Angeles on August 2, 1962, before Examiner Mark V. Chiesa.

The evidence shows that applicant failed his first examination. Ee was accorded two opportunities to tale a seconc exmination, one on July 27, 1962, at which time be aade no appeamance, and another on July 31, 1962, which be declined.

Said staff member testifled that applicant had failed to qualify.

Applicant presented no evidence of his qualifications and his testimony indicated that he bas been operating without the necessary authority.

The Commission, having considered the matter, finds that applicant does not possess the requisite qualifications for a household goods carrier permit.

II IS ORDERED that Application No. 44553, of Elder E. Gunning, be and it hereby is denied.
