ORDER

State of California, Department of Public Works,
 is hereby authorized to construct State Route 3 (US 99). North
 Mount Shasta Underpass at separated grades under the track of
 Southern Pacific Company, near Upton, Siskiyou County, at the
 location as shown by map (Exhibit B) attached to the applica-
 tion, to be identified as Crossing No. C-338.2-B. Construction
 and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an
 agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto,
 and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said cross-
 ing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with
 the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should
 the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the
 cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clear-
 ances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this
 order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing.
 This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three

years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
