ORDER

County of Sutter is hereby authorized to construct Reclama-
 tion Road at grade across a track of Southern Pacific Company near
 Robbins, Sutter County at the location described in the application
 to be identified as Crossing No. AF-96.6. Applicant shall bear entire
 construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet
 outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance
 cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than
 twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent.
 Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General
 Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing
 signs (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order,
 applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authoriza-
 tion shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be
 extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization
 may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety
 so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days
 after the date hereof.
