O R D E R

Pacific Electric Railway Company is hereby authorized to construct a drill track at grade across Huntzinger Avenue, in the City of Santa Ana, Orange County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6N-39.50-C.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, and width to be 25 feet, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three percent in accordance with plans attached to application. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

Upon completion of Crossing No. 6N-39.50-C, the existing crossing of Talbert Avenue (Crossing No. 6N-39.18-C) and Huntzinger Avenue (Crossing No. 6N-39.64-C) shall be eliminated.

Applicant declares that the owner and developer of the industrial property to be served by the proposed track desires rail service as soon as possible and requests waiver of the twenty-day waiting period.

The effective date of this order shall therefore be the date hereof.
