Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding six percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B) equipped with automatic gate arms. Applicantshall bear entire construction and maintenance experse.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this oxder, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that track construction work forces are completing nearby projects and desires early authorization in order to start immediate construction of the project herein
authorized. Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
