O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a drill track at grade across Taft Avenue in the City of Orange, Orange County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BM-514.74-C.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and 24 feet in width, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant declares that the industry to be served is moving from another location on short notice at great expense and desires track service as soon as possible.

The effective date of this order shall therefore be the date hereof.
