O P I N I O N

By application filed herein applicant seeks an order of this Commission revoking his certificate of public convenience and necessity as a highway common carrier.

Applicant alleges the following circumstances and conditions: (1) he has not been able to develop a substantial or profitable movement of commodities listed in said certificate; (2) the yearly cost of keeping and maintaining current applicant's tariff does not justify the expense of said tariffs; (3) gross revenue has fallen to a low level the last few years, and the operating costs have risen due to old equipment; (4) loss of freight revenue has resulted from the building boom and the new roads and freeways in the territory; (5) he has arranged with another trucking company to serve the remaining shippers so that the revocation of his certificate will cause no inconvenience to anyone.

The Commission finds that the revocation of applicant's authority will not be adverse to the public interest. Public hearing is not necessary.

ORDER

An application having been filed and the Commission having determined that it should be granted,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity acquired by Harold P. Schivo in Decision No. 38406 is hereby revoked and Local Freight Tariff No. 2 Cal. P. U. C. No. 2, issued by H. P. Schivo is hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
