IV-SCI-239-SJs will be carried over the
tracks of the Southern Pacific Company,
in the City of San Jose, referred to as
"Laurel Street Overhead Widening".

O R D E R

State of California, Department of Public Works, is hereby authorized to widen State Route 239 at separated grades over the tracks of Southern Pacific Company, in San Jose, Santa Clara County, at the location and substantially as shown in the application identified as Crossing No. E-45.3-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years

unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with.
The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the
date hereof.
