ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

The Commission directed defendant to repay to complainant, in accordance with an authorized water main extension refund contract, the sum of \$4,011.25 and to advise the Commission, in writing (a) when it had paid that sum and (b) when it had completed the connection with complainant's subdivision provided for by the contract (Decision No. 63982, dated July 24, 1962). The order further stated that upon receipt of such advice the Commission would dismiss the complaint.

Defendant having complied with the Commission's order and having filed the required advice,

IT IS ORDERED that the complaint herein is dismissed.
