SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

On October 16, 1962, the Commission issued Decision No. 64389 in this matter, said decision pertaining to refund payments due complainant for the period 1960-1961. Just prior to the close of business on the same day, the Commission received from defendant's attorney a statement as to refunds due complainant^{1/} for the period 1961-1962 and a further stipulation as to the assignment of the respective agreements involved.

The Commission finds that a supplemental order should be issued in this matter so as to set forth those amounts which defendant admits are due complainant for the 1961-1962 period.

Tract No. 2419:	Gross \$5,650.23;	Refund \$1,243.05
Tract No. 2519:	Gross \$ 933.50;	Refund \$ 326.73

Good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS ORDERED that Dyke Water Company, a California corporation, be and it is hereby directed to comply with its Main Extension Rule No. 15, and this Commission's Decision No. 61642, and its contract obligations and to make refund forthwith to Ralph B. Robbins in the amount of \$2,204.95, said amount being additional to that heretofore similarly ordered to be paid by this Commission's Decision No. 64389 issued October 16, 1962.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
