ORDER VACATING SUSPENSION
AND INVESTIGATION ORDER

On December 19, 1961, the Commission issued an order of investigation as above-entitled which, among other things, suspended to and including May 7, 1962, the changes contained on First Revised Sheet 5 and First Revised Sheet 13 of Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. 120-T filed under Advice Letter No. 8096 by The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company. Subsequently, on March 27, 1962, the period of suspension was extended to and including November 7, 1962. Prior to public hearing on the matter and in response to a written request filed by respondent, the changes contained on First Revised Sheet 5 and First Revised Sheet 13 of Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. 120-T filed under Advice Letter No. 8096 were rejected. Therefore, cause for suspension being removed, the suspension order of December 19, 1961 as subsequently modified, is vacated and set aside and this proceeding discontinued as of the date hereof.
