Edward M. Buttler requests a permit to operate as a household goods carrier within a 250-mile radius of Fresno.

A public hearing was held before Examiner Thomas E. Daly on September 20, 1962, at San Francisco.

It appears that pursuant to Section 5135 of the Public Utilities Code applicant was given a written examination in Fresno on June 14, 1962, which he failed to pass. It further appears that applicant was given a second written examination on July 26, 1962, and successfully passed said examination. A Commission staff member testified that applicant is now qualified to operate the proposed household goods service on a limited basis.

Upon consideration of the application and examination, and the evidence of qualification presented at the hearing, the Commission finds that applicant possesses sufficient knowledge, ability, integrity, financial resources and responsibility to perform the services of a household goods carrier as set forth in the following order.

IT IS ORDERED that, on the effective date of this decision, the Secretary of the Commission shall cause Household Goods Carrier Permit No. 10-9394-EG to be issued to Edward M. Buttler, inserting therein conditions and restrictions limiting applicant's operation to points within a radius of 250 miles of Fresno.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
