## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER.

In compliance with this Comission's Decision No. 635.3I, heretofore issued in this matter on April 6, 1962, Pacific Gas and Electric Company now seeks approval of an agreement by which it would (I) seli and transfer to complainant those gas and electric facilitices presently located on complainant's property and (2) install and sell to complainant ceztain additional electric facilities needed to permit complainant to serve certain of its buildings from the sacilities within the village.

The agreement is in Ietrer form and is dated August $\hat{3}$, 2962. It has been duly executed by defendant's San Joaquin Division manager and by complainant's president. It provides for payment by complajnant of a total consideration of \$47,653.36, with appropriate adjustment respecting the date of closing.

Under the Sacts obtaining, the Commission finds that the agreement as erecuted should be approved and that defendant should be authorized to eaxry out the tems thereof. Such findings, however, shall not be constinec to constitute a sinding as to the value of the properties authorized to be transferred.

Public hearing on the petition herein is not necessary. Good cause appearing therefor,
IT IS ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company be and 1: is herely authorized to seli and transfer to The Senior Citizens Village those gas and electric facilities described in that certain letter agreement between the two, dated August 3,1962 , in accordance with the terms thereof.
