O P I N I O N

Neal Milton and Raymond C. Irvine, doing business as Irvine-Milton Moving & Storage, request authority to transfer a household goods carrier permit to Raymond C. Irvine and Merle H. Fliflet, doing business as Irvine Moving Co.

A public hearing was held before Examiner Thomas E. Daly, on September 28, 1962, at San Francisco.

It appears that pursuant to Section 5135 of the Public Utilities Code Raymond C. Irvine was required to take a written examination on June 15, 1962, at Stockton, which he failed. It further appears that Raymond C. Irvine took a second written examination at Stockton on July 25, 1962, and successfully passed said examination.

A Commission staff member testified that applicant Raymond C. Irvine is now qualified to operate the proposed household goods service and the transfer will be authorized.

Upon consideration of the application and examination, and the evidence of qualification presented at the hearing, the

Commission finds that the proposed transfer will not be adverse to the public interest and that Raymond C. Irvine possesses sufficient knowledge, ability, integrity, financial resources and responsibility to perform the services of a household goods carrier as set forth in the following order.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that, on the effective date of this decision, the Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause Household Goods Carrier Permit No. 50-4321-HG to be transferred to Raymond C. Irvine and Merle H. Fliflet.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
