O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct one side track at grade across Anaheim-Puente Road in the City of Industry, County of Los Angeles, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. B-502.4. Applicant shall bear the entire construction expense. Construction of crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, and of a width of 36 feet, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding four percent, in accordance with plan attached to the application. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B), supplemented with automatic crossing gates.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied

with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
