In the matter of the application of the City of Sacramento for an order authorizing construction of a crossing at grade with the tracks of the Southern Pacific Company spur track #2 at 24th Avenue in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento. California.	}	Application No. 44992
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O R D E R

City of Sacramento is hereby authorized to construct 24th Avenue at grade across a spur track of Southern Pacific Company in the City of Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. D-132.7-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than fifty-two feet and grades of approach not greater than one percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization

may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
