ORDER FIXING EFFECTIVE DATE
OF INCREASE IN FOREIGN EXCHANGE RATES
OF ROSEVILLE TELEPHONE COMPANY

It appearing that by Decision No. 64897, dated February 5, 1963, the Commission, among other things, authorized Roseville Telephone Company to increase rates and charges for foreign exchange telephone service in the Roseville exchange, said authority to be effective twenty days after the date of said decision; it further appearing that a petition for rehearing of Decision No. 64897 has been filed by The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company on February 15, 1963 and that said petition has stayed the effective date of the order contained in said

decision in accordance with the terms of section 1733 of the Public Utilities Code; and it further appearing that said petition does not involve said authorization of Roseville Telephone Company to increase rates and charges for foreign exchange telephone service in the Roseville exchange;

IT IS ORDERED that the effective date of Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 64897 shall be the date hereof.
