OPINION and ORDER

A Commission staff member having determined, after examination and appraisal as provided in Section 5135 of the Public Utilities Code, that applicant is not qualified for a permit as a Household Goods Carrier, the matter was set for hearing at Los Angeles on January 31, 1963, before Examiner Chiesa.

The evidence shows and we find that on November 19, 1962, the responsible managing employee, Paul J. Cupp, designated by applicant to take the written examination in accordance with the provisions of Section 5135 of the Public Utilities Code, has failed said examination; that a second examination was scheduled for December 17, 1962, and again for January 18, 1963; that applicant received written notices of said examination at her address as shown in her application; that she failed to appear for said examination and also failed to appear for the hearing

on January 31, 1963; that applicant was duly served with a copy of the notice of hearing; that applicant is not qualified for a Household Goods Carrier permit.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 45127 is denied.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
