OPINION and ORDER

A Commission staff member having determined, after examination and appraisal as provided in Section 5135 of the Public Utilities Code, that applicant is not qualified for a Household Goods Carrier permit, the matter was set for hearing at Los Angeles on January 31, 1963, before Examiner Chiesa.

The evidence shows and we find that on October 29, 1962, applicant failed to pass the prescribed written examination; that a second examination was scheduled for November 26, 1962, and again for December 17, 1962; that applicant received written notices of said examination at his address as shown in his application; that he did not make an appearance at the time and place for said examination; that he was present at the hearing and chose not to testify or offer any additional evidence of his qualifications; that applicant has not qualified for a Household Goods Carrier permit.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 45083 is denied.
