ORDER VACATING ORDER OF
SUSPENSION OF OPERATIVE RIGHT

The express corporation prescriptive operative right of San Diego Forwarding Express, a corporation, has been under suspension since January 31, 1963, for failure to have on file with the Commission the required freight classification. The suspension was effected by Decision No. 64750 dated January 8, 1963, in this proceeding.

On February 4, 1963, Western Classification Committee, Agent, filed Supplement 2 to its Western Classification 78 reinstating San Diego Forwarding Express as a participant in said classification effective March 5, 1963. Inasmuch as the required classification is now on file, Decision No. 64750, supra, will be vacated.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 64750 dated January 8, 1963, in Application No. 34216 is hereby vacated and set aside.
