ORDER VACATING ORDER OF
SUSPENSION OF OPERATIVE RIGHT

Decision No. 64753 dated January 8, 1963, provided for the suspension of the certificate of public convenience and necessity of J & J Truck Line, a corporation, unless it shall have filed with this Commission a written response to the order requesting public hearing or shall have filed the proper and lawful freight classification required by Sections 486 and 493 of the Public Utilities Code in which event the effective date of the order would be stayed.

On January 18, 1963, J & J Truck Line filed an application requesting public hearing thereby staying the effective date of the order. On February 4, 1963, Western Classification Committee, Agent, filed Supplement 2 to its Western Classification 78 reinstating J & J Truck Line as a participant in said classification effective March 5, 1963. Inasmuch as the required classification is now on file, Decision No. 64753, supra, will be vacated.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 64753 dated January 8, 1963, in Application No. 40923 is hereby vacated and set aside.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
